## Royal Life Saving Society

The Royal Lifesaving Society NSW will receive \$5,800 under the Community Grants program provided by Cessnock Leagues Club.

The project will give intensive learn to swim lessons over two weeks during the January school holidays with 30 children identified from low socio economic backgrounds who have limited swimming ability.



The learn to swim classes will be held daily with the project not only providing local disadvantaged children with the opportunity to learn to swim but an opportunity to have some fun and something to look forward to over the two weeks. Club president Bruce Wilson, said figures released by the Royal Life Saving Society NSW say that drowning is the second cause of accidental death in children aged one to 14 years and support under the grants scheme could help reduce this tragedy.
